



Montage Suggestions

A picture montage is a great way to tell the story of the guest or guests of honor's life. There are many ways of showing a picture montage, the most common two ways are either throughout the entire event or towards the end of dinner. When possible, we always suggest having at least one photo of every guest at your event.

Montage Played Throughout The Event

Showing the photos throughout the event is the best option if you have more than 100 photos and do not wish to have everyone stop and watch the montage at the same time. Simply supply us with a USB Flash Drive with all of your digital photos in no particular order and they will be shown with transitions randomly throughout the event. Be sure to crop the photos as they will show on our screen just as they show on your screen at home.

Sit & Watch Montage

The sit and watch montage is best if you are looking to show the photos in chronological order. The montage is commonly shown towards the end of dinner. The length of the montage is very important as there is such thing as too long!

We suggest no longer than 4-5 minutes for kids (40-50 photos) & 8 -10 minutes for teens & adults (80-100 photos)

Simply supply us with a USB Flash Drive with all of your digital photos in number order, so that the name of the picture file corresponds to its location in the montage. For example, the baby photo will be named "1" and the second photo for the montage will be named "2". Be sure to crop the photos as they will show on our screen just as they show on your screen at home.

The sit and watch montage has music that is played along with it. Pick **one to four** song choices depending on the amount of photos & length of your montage. On the next page you will find our **Montage Song Suggestions**.
